This Indenture, Made this Sixth day of January, in the year of our Lord, Nineteen hundred and three, between A. C. Silber and Lizzie Silber, his wife, of the City of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Fanny Bergman, of the second part:

**Witnesseth**, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the south line of Warren street in the City of Lawrence with the east line of Illinois street produced south from the City of Lawrence, thence running east on the south line of Warren about 117 feet, thence south 230 feet more or less to an alley; thence west 117 feet to the east line of said Illinois street produced; thence north 230 feet more or less to beginning, being the west 117 feet of lot No. 1 of Christian's sub-division of Block No. 40 of Lewis' Second Addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Nine hundred Dollars, according to the terms of One certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part Payable five years after date with interest thereon according to the terms of said note and coupon thereunto attached.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns, or by whomsoever or any number thereof on account of criminal attachment any.
