This Indenture, Made this 2nd day of January in the year of our Lord Nineteen hundred and three thousand, between Ernest Able and Rosina Able his wife of Johnson in the County of Kansas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and C. A. Hill of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The North West quarter of Section Eighteen (18) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty One (21) East of 6th Principal Meridian in Kansas containing one hundred fifty acres more or less - Also about two (2) acres of the Northeast quarter of Section Thirteen (13) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty (20) location described more minutely by starting at the Southeast corner of aforesaid Northeast quarter thence North over the Section line to the middle of Little Wakarusa Creek thence down the center of said creek to the crossing of stream by of a road section line continued North said tract lying in the bend of said stream on the east side thereof -

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Ernest Able and Rosina Able do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three thousand dollars and the interest thereon from March 1<sup>st</sup> 1903, according to the terms of one certain Bearer Note this day executed and delivered by the said Ernest Able and Rosina Able to the said party of the second part Note for \$3000, payable six months from March 1<sup>st</sup> 1903 with interest at six per cent per annum and payable annually

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the surplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part or their heirs and assigns.
