This Indenture, Made this sixty-fifth day of May in the year of our Lord, Nineteen
hundred and three, between D. P. Katherman and Barbara D. Katherman
his wife of Lawrence in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and
Joseph E. Rizzo of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Two Hundred Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part hus heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Part of the South West quarter of Section No 31 Township
12 Range 20 described as follows: Begun at a point on the East line of New Hampshire Street
in the City of Lawrence produced South Thirty three (33) feet from the North line of Adams Street,
then run East parallel with said North line of Adams Street Eighty three and one third
(83 1/3) feet, thence run South on a line parallel with the said East line of New Hampshire
street produced South One hundred and Eighty five (185) feet, thence at right angle run
West Eighty three and one third (83 1/3) feet, thence at right angle, and on what would
be the produced East line of New Hampshire Street run North One hundred
and Eighty five (185) feet to the place of beginning, all in the City of Lawrence, in
said County and State

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said
parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that
at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible
estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of
Two Hundred Dollars
according to the terms of two certain Notes and Coupons this day executed
and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part
being part purchase money

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or
interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall
become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part hus executors, administrators and assigns, at any
time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from
such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if
any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part their
heirs and assigns.
