This Indenture, Made this 19th day of April in the year of our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and four, between Adam H. Williams and Alice J. Williams, his wife, of Lawrence, Kansas, of the first part, and Merchants Loan & Savings Bank of Lawrence, Kansas, of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred forty three and 77/100 Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of the second part its successors and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Lot number one hundred and thirty one (131) on Main Street, in block number forty two (42), in that part of the City of Lawrence known as West Lawrence.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said Adam Williams and Alice J. Williams, his wife, do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three hundred and forty three and 77/100 Dollars according to the terms of One certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Adam H. Williams and Alice J. Williams, his wife, to the said part of the second part of even date herewith, payable on or before three years after date, with interest at eight per cent per annum after date.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part its successors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
