This Indenture, made this 3rd day of December, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and five, between Joseph Morris Banks and Ethel Maria Banks his wife of Huron, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and The Board of Trustees of Ottawa University of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Sixteen hundred 600 Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part 125 heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

One West forty acres (40) of the North east quarter (N.E. 40) of Section Nine (9) Township Fifteen (15) Range Eighteen (18). Also an acre of land described as follows: Commencing at the N.E. corner of the North East quarter (N.E. 40) of Section Nine (9) Township Fifteen (15) Range Eighteen (18), thence West in the North line of said 40 section so rods; thence South parallel with the east line of said 40 section to the South line of said Section; thence east on the South line of said 40 section so rods to the S.E. corner of said 40 section; thence North in the East line of said 40 section to return to the point of beginning - being the east 80 acres of said North west quarter (N.W. 40) of said Section Nine (9) Township Fifteen (15) Range Eighteen (18).

With all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

Sixteen hundred

according to the terms of One certain indenture made this day executed and delivered by the said Joseph Morris Banks and Ethel Maria Banks to the said party of the second part due and payable in 5 years from this date at the City Banks Office, with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum payable annually on Feb. 1st with privilege to the party of the first part \$100.00 every month thereafter at any interest payment, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or if the party of the first part shall, when the same shall become due, fail to pay up the same, then the same shall become void, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall then pass to the said party of the second part, executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, for the compensation, full damage, and all his whole money received and obtained by him, or any of them, by reason of making such sale, and the party of the first part shall receive the proceeds of such sales to retain the amount due for principal and interest, together with the cost of all charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any, he shall then pay by the party of the first part to the party of the second part, and all the expenses incident thereto, and receive the overplus, and if there be any balance left, he shall pay to the party of the first part, and all the expenses incident thereto, the same as furnished and assigned.
