This Indenture, Made this Twenty-fifth day of October in the year of our Lord, Thirteen Hundred  
and Nine (1799), between Harriet Carter (Widow)

Mo. C. B. Stiles, of same place of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Fifty (\$50) Dollars,  
to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha 2 sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage  
to the said part 2 of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas,  
and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Lot 15-16-17-18-19 in James Sub-Division of Block  
No. Seven (7) Early Addition to N. City of Lawrence.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part 1 of the first part therein. And the said  
Harriet Carter do 2 hereby covenant and agree that  
at the delivery hereof that she is the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible  
estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of  
Fifty (\$50)  
according to the terms of one certain note this day executed  
and delivered by the said Harriet Carter to the said part 2 of the second part  
her heirs and assigns, said note due on or before three  
years. Interest 5% Semi-annually.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or  
interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount  
shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part 2 of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns, at  
any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising  
from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the  
overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part 2 making such sale, on demand, to said Harriet Carter, her  
heirs and assigns.
