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This Indenture, Made this Twelfth day of December, in the year of our Lord, Nineteen
Hundred and Nine, between Thomas Bush Gray and Viola M
Gray husband and wife of Douglas in the County of
Jefferson and State of Kansas, of the first part, and
Moses Courtney of Willard County Kansas of the second part:
Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Twelve Hundred and 75 Dollars,
to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha^d sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage
to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas,
and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:
The West Fifteen (.05) acres of the South Twentieth (.05) acres of the North
Thirty (.05) acres of the East half of the South West quarter of Section
No. Four (4), in Township No Fifteen (15) of Range No Twenty (20) East
of the Sixth Principal Meridian, and also a tract containing
Six (.6) acres in said South West Quarter of Section No. Four
(4) Township Fifteen (15) Range No Twenty (20), bounded as follows; Commencing at the
North West corner of said South West quarter, thence North Twenty (20) rods, thence South Twentieth (20) rods
and twelve feet, thence South West forty rods and twelve feet, thence West
seventy eight rods and twelve feet, thence thence North Thirty two rods to place of
appurtenance containing six (.06) acres of more or less, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties
Thomas Bush Gray and Viola M. Gray do hereby covenant and agree that
at the delivery hereof they and the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible
estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

Twelve Hundred

according to the terms of me certain not this day executed
and delivered by the said Thomas Bush Gray and Viola M. Gray to the said party of the second part
Mid December 15th 1905; Due December 15th 1907 with interest from
date until paid at the rate of seven per cent per annum.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or
interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount
shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at
any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising
from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the
overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said Thomas Bush Gray or his heirs.
