This Indenture, Made this 15th day of March in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred & seven, between James M. Shepherd and Ella B. Shepherd (His wife) of Shawnee and State of Kansas, of the first part, and N. E. Shumway of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$1500⁰⁰ Fifteen Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The South west (1/4) Quarter of Section numbered Eleven (11) in Township numbered Fourteen (14) in Range number Eighteen (18) East of The Sixth (6) P.M. Containing (160) acres more or less.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said James M. Shepherd & Ella B. Shepherd do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claimers whatsoever.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen Hundred according to the terms of Note certain premises only, this day executed and delivered by the said James M. Shepherd & Ella B. Shepherd to the said party of the second part

and made being given for the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, dated at Topeka Kansas, March 15th 1907, due and payable in five years from date hereof with interest thereon from date hereof until paid, according to the terms of said note and coupons hereunto attached and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises, hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said James M. Shepherd & Ella B. heirs and assigns.
