This Indenture, Made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and Eighty; between Eddison P. Forth and Anna E. Forth of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and J. P. Hart of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Thirty One Hundred & no Dollars, to thunder paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The South half of the South West Quarter (1/4) of Section Three (3) and the north one fourth (1/4) of the North west quarter, (1/4) of Section Ten (10) all in Township Fifteen (15) of Range Eighteen (18) East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. and being 120 acres more or less,

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Eddison P. Forth and Anna E. Forth do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Thirty one Hundred & no according to the terms of one certain præsens, this day executed, and delivered by the said J. P. Hart to the said parties of the second part

and note of even date herewith, and due in five years with interest at 6% per annum payable annually, to pay \$100<sup>00</sup> or more at and interest payment, and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute and the whole sum shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said Eddison P. Forth and Anna E. Forth, their heirs and assigns.
