

line between Sections 20 and 29 T. 14, R. 20.
 Second, that the land owned by Holmes in the
 S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 20 is not at present under fence,
 that the East part is plow land and the West
 part waste land, and that the land owned
 by White in the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 29 is under fence, part
 of which is the fence in dispute. The land west
 the West part of this fence is being used as pasture.
 Third, the East 50 rods, or thereabouts of this fence
 in dispute is of sage hedge, the balance of wire and
 brush.

Fourth, it appears from the evidence that the said fence
 was put out and has been maintained by the
 owners of the property now owned by the said Frank
 White, but in as much as the said fence so far
 as the hedge goes has drawn its substance from the
 soil of both farms it is hereby decided that the said
 Holmes becomes an interested party in the said fence.
 Fifth, it is further decided that the said B. J. Holmes
 and his succeeding occupants have and kept in
 good repair the East $\frac{1}{2}$ or the East 30 rods of the
 said fence in dispute and that he pay the said
 Frank White therefore the sum of \$7.50 in cash.

Sixth, that the said Frank White or his succeeding
 occupants have and keep in good repair the West
 $\frac{1}{2}$ or the West 30 rods of the said fence in dispute.
 Seventh, that each party is hereby empowered to
 trim and remove weeds and all damaging
 limbs or brush on their respective sides of the
 said fence, to be removed in such a manner
 as not to injure or destroy the fence proper.
 Eighth, that the said parties hereto to wit Frank
 White and B. J. Holmes each pay one half of
 the cost hereby made amounting to \$3.50,
 making \$2.50 for each to pay. And it is further
 provided and decreed that if the said damages
 and costs assessed be not paid within 30 days
 that civil action follow as provided by law.
