And Whereas, the time of payment of the said sum of five thousand (\$5000) dollars remaining unpaid on the principal of said bond and mortgage was extended to January 26th 1906, by an extension agreement dated January 10th 1904; And whereas, no part of the said principal sum of five thousand (\$5000) dollars has been paid to said Insurance Company on said bond and mortgage, and the interest has been paid to the first day of January 1902, and there remains unpaid on said bond and mortgage, of the principal thereof, the just and full sum of five thousand (\$5000) Dollars, with interest thereon from the first day of January 1902. And Whereas, the said William Schaackel has requested the said Insurance Company to extend the time of payment of the said principal sum of five thousand (\$5000) dollars remaining unpaid on said bond and mortgage, until the twenty sixth (26th) day of January A.D. nineteen hundred and Eleven (1911) with the privilege of paying one hundred (\$100) dollars or more of said principal sum, on any interest paying day after the twenty-sixth (26th) day of January A.D. nineteen hundred and seven (1907) and before maturity, and the said Insurance Company has consented and agreed to make such extension as
