This Indenture, Made this thirtieth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six between Addie Jones and W. C. Jones her husband of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part and Paul R. Brooks of the same place of the second part; Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: - Lots two (2) and three (3) in North East Central subdivision of Six (6) acres in the North West quarter of the South west quarter of Section No 27 - in Township No. 12 - of Range No 20 - in that part of the City of Lawrence formerly known as North Lawrence, Douglas County Kansas, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Addie Jones and W. C. Jones hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred Dollars according to the terms one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Addie and W.
