

Know all men by these presents, That for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Two Hundred \$2200⁰⁰ Dollars to me, E. Hanson in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I, E. Hanson of the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and assign and set over to W^m L. Palm, of the City of Denver, County of Denver and State of Colorado a certain Indenture of Mortgage executed by Lizzie L. Colburn of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, on the 29th day of August 1903, to me A. Palm, Trustee and which said mortgage was afterwards on the 12th day of February 1904, duly assigned, transferred and set over by said A. Palm Trustee to said E. Hanson and which assignment was recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, on the 18th day of February 1904 at 8.20 o'clock A.M. in Book 37 at page 616, which said mortgage covered the following described real estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit: The South Three (88.5) feet of Lot No. One Hundred & Sixty (166) and all Lot No. One Hundred and Sixty Eight (168) on Ohio Street in City of Lawrence Douglas County, Kansas, together with the note therein referred to. Said mortgage was recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of said County of Douglas and State of Kansas, on the 29th day of August, 1903, at 4.54 o'clock P.M. in Book 42 of Mortgages at page 229, to have and to hold the said note and mortgage and debt thereby secured and all interest conveyed by said mortgage in and to said land therein described to W^m L. Palm his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever for his sole use and benefit.
