

former consumers are now or hereafter to be connected up with the Kansas Natural Gas Company's mains in said counties, and all other property now composing and that may hereafter during the life of this indenture be added to the said Company's holdings.

Second. All the rights that said The Kansas Farmer Gas Company has obtained by reason of, oral permission, occupancy and possession of the highways, public grounds and farm lands in said counties to construct, maintain and operate said rural systems of pipe lines for supplying the farmers in said counties with gas.

Third. The said The Kansas Farmers Gas Company's rights in, to and under a certain written arrangement dated the 7th day of October A. D. 1905, with the Kansas Natural Gas Company, whereby it agrees to furnish said The Kansas Farmers Gas Company with natural gas to supply the farmers along the mains in said counties.

To Have And To Hold the said premises to said grantee, the said The Banking Trust Company and its successors, in trust, nevertheless, for the purposes and upon the conditions as follows:

Whereas the said The Kansas Farmers Gas Company, the grantor herein, has issued and is justly indebted upon five hundred bonds, numbered consecutively from one to five hundred, inclusive, together for thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), bearing even date herewith, the first one hundred of said bonds being of the denomination of one hundred dollars (\$100), and the remaining four hundred being of the denomination of fifty dollars (\$50) each, and payable to bearer on February 15, 1917, with interest payable annually as evidenced by ten interest coupons attached to each of said bonds, both bonds and coupons being payable at said Bankers Trust Company, Kansas City, Kansas, Mo., Therefore, fully to secure the payment
