Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in
consideration of the sum of \$300. Three hundred
Dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and
by these presents, do grant bargain sell and
convey to the said of the second part, his
heirs and assigns forever, the following tract
or parcel of land situated in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas, described as
follows, to wit: The South forty five feet of

Street in the City of Lawrence, with the appurtenances
and all the estate, title and interest of the said
parties of the first part therein And the said
