REAL ESTATE:

All the land lying east of the railroad right of way of the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company and South of Scatter Creek, in lot twelve, section twenty-nine; and all of the land lying east of the railroad right of way of the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company, in lot one, section thirty-two, less fourteen (14) acres off of the south side of said lot one of section thirty-two; all in township twenty-six, range eighteen, in Allen County, Kansas; and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point five hundred and twelve (512) feet south and two thousand three hundred and thirty and one-half (2,305½) feet east of the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of section thirty-one, township twenty-six, range eighteen east, in Allen County, Kansas, running thence south along the east line of the right of way of the Missouri, Kansas & Texas Railway Company four hundred and six (406) feet to an iron pin; thence east one thousand fifty (1,050) feet to the corner line of the Neosho River; thence in a northerly direction along the center line of the said Neosho River to a point where Scatter Creek empties into said river; thence in a westerly direction along the center line of said Scatter Creek to where the same intersects the right of way of the Missouri, Kansas & Texas Railway Company; thence south along the east line of the said right of way of the Missouri, Kansas Railway Company, two thousand, one hundred and fifteen (2,115) feet to the place of beginning, containing 30.66 acres, more or less; excepting and reserving therefrom unto The Petrolia Tower Lot and Land Company all of the oil, gas and mineral in and under the said piece of land; all rentals and dues that may accrue upon or under any oil, gas, or mineral leases that are (January 31, 1906) upon the said piece of land or any part thereof and also the right to operate the present wells only now (January 31, 1906) on the said described piece of land, with the right to maintain necessary engines, derricks, pumping jacks, oil lines, shackle rods and tanks in the production of oil and gas from the present wells only, and with the right of egress and ingress to such wells and the right to remove the same.

Being the same premises conveyed by Jesse C. McDowell and Caroline McDowell, his wife, to the Pipe Line Company by deed dated January 31, 1906, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Allen County, Kansas, on March 12, 1906, in Book 38 of Deeds, at page 195.

Also, a one-half interest in all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Allen, and State of Kansas, and described as follows, to-wit: one acre, more or less, in lot twelve, section twenty-nine, township twenty-six, range eighteen, the same lying immediately west of the M. K. & T. Railway and north of Scatter Creek; and also one and one-quarter acres, more or less, in lot twelve, section twenty-nine, township twenty-six, range eighteen east, the same being immediately west of that lot deed to Larsons on February 14, 1907, and east of that lot heretofore deed by Wm. Sheffield to Whaley, same being north of Scatter Creek.

GAS COMPRESSOR HOUSE: 196' x 82' x 27' concrete foundations, steel frame, steel truss roof, covered with corrugated iron. Walls 5' of cement block. Main span 66'; 8' lean-to on each side.
