That part of Johnson County 16-Inch Extension in Wyandotte County, being the part from 391 $\frac{1}{2}$ Street and Hudson Road to Rosedale, Reducing Station, is laid under the Grants of Right of Way scheduled under Rights of Way, Kansas City 16-Inch Line, as Nos. 374, 375, 376, 377, 378, 379, 380, 381, 382, 383, 384, 385, 386 and Rosedale Ordinance No. 321.

PETROLIA-SMITH 16-INCH LINE.

All that certain gas pipe line, approximately 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles in length, constructed during the year 1907, starting at the Petrolia Compressor Station, in Section 31, Township 26, Range 18, Allen County, Kansas, and extending thence in a generally southerly direction, and parallel to the Kansas City 16-Inch Line, through Allen County, Neosho County and into Wilson County, to a point in Section 20, Township 27, Range 17, at which point the line is connected into the Kansas City 16-Inch Line.

Being the same gas pipe line conveyed to the Pipe Line Company by The Kaw Gas Company, The Jantha Construction Company and The Kansas Natural Gas, Oil, Pipe Line & Improvement Company by deed dated December 28, 1907 (recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Allen County, Kansas, on .. at Page ..; and in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Neosho County, Kansas, on .. at Page ..; and in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Wilson County, Kansas, on .. at Page ..), and therein described as follows:

"That certain sixteen inch steel gas trunk pipe line laid with rubber packer couplings and commencing at its connection with the Petrolia Compressor Station of the party of the second part" (Pipe Line Company) "in Allen County, Kansas, and running thence in a generally southwesterly direction about six miles to its connection with the Newton Smith pressure station in Section Twenty, Township Twenty-seven south, Range Seventeen east, in Wilson County, Kansas."

XIII.

RIGHTS OF WAY, PETROLIA-SMITH 16-INCH LINE.

All the Pipe Line Company's right, title, claim and interest in, and to, or by, through or under certain grants of right of way over, and across lands, and along, and across, highways in Allen, Neosho and Wilson Counties, Kansas. The interest of the Pipe Line Company therein and thereunder is that interest conveyed to the Pipe Line Company by The Kaw Gas Company, and The Kansas Natural Gas, Oil, Pipe Line & Improvement Company by deed dated December 28, 1907, executed by said two companies, and also by The Jantha Construction Company, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Allen County, Kansas, on .. at Page ..; and in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Neosho County, Kansas, on .. at Page ..; and in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Wilson County, Kansas, on .. at Page .. (which deed also conveys to the Pipe Line Company the

Petrolia-Smith 16-Inch-Extension), the interest of the Pipe Line Company in the grants numbered 2, 4, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 in the following schedule being in said deed described as follows: "All of the following rights of way upon which the said Petrolia-Smith Line is laid," and the interest of the Pipe Line Company in grants numbered 1, 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 16 and 17 in said schedule being in said deed described as follows: "So much of the following described rights of way as is embraced within two parallel lines each drawn eighteen inches from the centre of the said pipe line" (Petrolia-Smith 16-Inch Extension) "where it is laid upon such rights of way, each of said lines to be eighteen inches, respectively, to the right and left of such centre line."
