All that certain gas pipe line, constructed during the year 1907, starting at the southern terminus of the Kansas City 16-Inch Line, which terminus is located at a point in Section 15, Township 20, Range 10, Wilson County, Kansas, and running thence in a generally southerly direction.

REAL ESTATE:

COMPRESSOR STATION:

All that certain piece or parcel of land situate in Anderson County, Kansas, and being all that part of Sections Twenty-nine and Thirty lying east of the track of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad Company, in Township Nineteen, Range Twenty, and bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the railroad right of way eight and seventy-five one-hundredths (8-75/100) chains west from the Northeast corner of Section Thirty; thence eastwardly (V.A. 8° 20' east) eight and seventy-five one-hundredths (8-75/100) chains to the section corner; thence south nine degrees fifteen minutes east, twenty-nine and eighty hundredths (29-80/100) chains to an iron pin set on the west side of the county road; thence south eighty-five degrees forty minutes west, two and fifty-three one-hundredths (2-53/100) chains to a stone set at the right of way of the Santa Fe Railroad; thence in a northwesterly direction along said right of way to the place of beginning, containing in all twelve acres, more or less.

Being the same piece or parcel of land conveyed by William Inge, *et al.*, to Cornelius Scully, by deed dated May 13, 1907, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anderson County, Kansas, in Book 66, at Page 416, and conveyed by Cornelius Scully, *et al.*, to the Pipe Line Company, by deed dated December 28, 1907, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anderson County, Kansas, on in Book , at Page .

Also the right of constructing and maintaining a certain pond, the said pond to be so constructed as to prevent the water from overflowing and standing on more than one and eighty-two one-hundredths acres; said one and eighty-two one-hundredths acres of land being on the west side of the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 19, Range 20, in Anderson County, Kansas, described as follows:—

Commencing at a point in the centre of the road 1000 feet south of the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 19, Range 20; thence south with the centre of road 600 feet to a point; thence east 40 feet to a point; thence in a northeasterly direction 710 feet to a point 240 feet east of the centre of said road; thence in a southwesterly direction 273 feet to the place of beginning.

Being the same right granted by Helena Walken, a widow, to the Kansas Natural Gas Company by agreement dated November 9, 1907, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anderson County, Kansas, in Miscellaneous Records Book E, at Pages 318 and 319; and conveyed by the Kansas Natural Gas Company to the Pipe Line Company by deed dated December 28, 1907, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anderson County, Kansas, on in Book , at Page .

RIVER PUMP HOUSE:

All that certain piece or parcel of land situate in Anderson County, Kansas, and being two acres of land in the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-two, Township Nineteen, Range Twenty, and described as follows: Beginning at a point fifty-six and ninety one-hundredths chains south and fourteen and eighteen one-hundredths chains east from the Northwest Corner of said Section Thirty-two; thence north three hundred feet; thence east two hundred and ninety and four-tenths feet; thence south three hundred feet to the center of north Pottawatomie Creek; thence west two hundred and ninety and four-tenths feet to the place of beginning.

Being the same piece or parcel of land conveyed by John Horman, *et al.*, to Cornelius Scully by deed dated October 16, 1907, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anderson County, Kansas, in Deed Book, Volume 71, at Page 326, and conveyed by Cornelius Scully, *et al.*, to the Pipe Line Company by deed dated December 28, 1907, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anderson County on in Deed Book, Volume , at Page .

BUILDINGS:

GAS COMPRESSOR HOUSE—32' x 92' x 23' 7 1/2". Concrete foundations steel frame, steel truss roof, covered with No. 22 corrugated galvanized iron. Walls 5' of brick and No. 22 galvanized iron. Main span 66' 6 1/2" 8' x 14' 2 1/2" high lean to on each side.

AUXILIARY BUILDING—2 Sections, concrete foundations.

Dynamo Room and Machine Shop: 42' x 68' x 12' with a central truss 26' high x 18' wide. Steel frame, steel truss roof covered with No. 20 corrugated, galvanized iron. Walls 4' of cement block and No. 22 galvanized iron; 12' 3" x 33' x 7' lean to on one side for boilers.

Pump and Store Rooms: 68' x 30' x 12', steel frame steel truss roof covered with No. 20 galvanized, corrugated iron. Walls 4' of cement block and No. 22 galvanized iron.

GASOMETER AND METER HOUSE—26' x 16' x 8'. Concrete foundations, steel frame, steel truss roof covered with No. 20 corrugated, galvanized iron. Walls No. 22 galvanized iron. 2 No. 22 galvanized iron partitions.

REGULATOR HOUSE—20' x 20' x 8'. Concrete foundations, steel frame, steel truss roof covered with No. 20 corrugated, galvanized iron.

RIVER PUMP HOUSE—18' x 31' x 8'. Concrete foundations, wood frame, walls and roof covered with No. 18 corrugated, galvanized iron. Concrete pit 12' x 12' x 20' deep.

TENEMENTS—

6 Cottages: 34' x 24' x 10'. One story frame, shingle roof, stone foundations, 5 rooms.
1 Boarding House: 36' x 28' x 18'. 2 story, frame, shingle roof, stone foundations, 10 rooms.
Above houses are provided with plumbing, gas, water and sewer connections.

1 Central oiling system for feeding lubricating oil to engines.
All necessary foundations, piping, wiring, instruments and equipment for the operation of the above engines.

2 160 H. P. Elyria tandem single acting gas engines.
2 100 K. W. 250 volt Westinghouse compound generators.
2 High pressure gas starting tanks, 24" x 56".

Switch Board—2 generator and 2 feeder panels; 400 ampere, 250 volts capacity, complete with all necessary instruments
