This Indenture, Made this first day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eight, between William T. Sinclair and Hattie E. Sinclair his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Edward S. Hayes of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred (\$1100.) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Commencing at the South East corner of the North East quarter of Section No. 24, in Township No. 14, Range No. 11, East, thence running north 10 chains and 50 links to the bank of the Kansas River, in the same place or less than north 82° west 23 chains 20 links to a stake, thence south parallel with the east line of said quarter section 30 chains 35 links to the south line of said quarter section, thence east 12 chains and 35 links to the place of beginning, containing 15 acres more or less; Also all accretions to the above land from the Kansas River; Also, a right of way along the south side of said north east quarter of Section No. 24, westward to the public highway, the above described land being intended to include the 5 acres deeded to Elv. S. Hayes by deed recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, in Book 28 page 506 and the 25 acres deeded to Wm. Hayes by deed recorded in said office in Book 47 page 56, the above land being subject to the right of way of the Kansas City, Topeka and Western Railroad, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said

William T. Sinclair & Hattie E. Sinclair do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefensible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances that they will warrant & defend the same in the quiet & peaceable possession of said second party, his heirs & assigns forever against all persons lawfully claiming the same. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Eleven Hundred Dollars

according to the terms of one certain mortgage note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part, to the said party of the second part in twelve years from date hereof, with interest from date to maturity as evidenced by coupons attached thereto, and interest after maturity or default at the rate of 12% per annum until fully paid in cash or by Sheriff's sale of above described property, and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
