This Indenture, Made this 22nd day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eight, between R. B. Wagstaff E. L. Jacobs J. W. Blackwell and E. B. Schall of the Alpha Chi Fraternity in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and J. W. Blackwell of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand One Hundred (\$1100.00) DOLLARS, then duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

Lots Five (5) Six (6) Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Four (4) of the Babcock Addition to the City of Lawrence lying one hundred and fifty (150) feet on Tennessee Street and two hundred and twenty-two (222) feet on Ontario Street west from Tennessee Street,

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said Parties of the first part trustees as aforesaid do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances except one mortgage for \$1100.00 caused by J.W. Blackwell & wife Adeline Blackwell, his wife, to Elsie A. Phillips, recorded in Book 40 at page 534. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of \$1100.00

according to the terms of one certain date this day executed and delivered by the said parties the first part trustee as aforesaid to the said party of the second part on July 1st, 1909, interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from July 1st, 1908.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part trustee aforesaid, heirs and assigns.
