This Indenture, Made this Twenty-fifth of July, in the year of our Lord Nineteen
hundred and ninety, between James H. Dean & Mary C. Dean
his wife, of Douglas, in the County of
Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and
Mary H. Dean of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Thirteen Hundred (\$1300.) DOLLARS,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The South West quarter of Section No 28, also the following: Begin at the South west corner of the south half of the north half of the North west 1/4 of a section in the 28th range north 30° E. 93 chains to a stone in the Clinton road, thence south 45° E. 4.39 chains, thence North 30° E. 4.77 chains to a stone, thence South 77° E. 4.53 chains, thence south 80° W. 75 chains, thence North 9° E. 13.35 chains beginning. Also begin on the east line of the south east quarter of Section No 28, stop just where the said line intersects the center of the Lawrence Emporia State Road, thence North 30° E. 100 more or less to a point 5 rods South of the south line of said 1/4 sec. thence west 20 rods, thence North 77° into more or less to intersect the center of said road, thence northwesterly along the center of said road to place of beginning, except 1/40th of an acre more or less in the South West corner thereof conveyed to C. J. Barley by deed recorded in Book "O" of Deeds, at page 37. All of above described land, being in Township No. 13, South of Range No. 10 East, subject to a prior mortgage of \$1400.00 to the National Home Life Insurance Company, dated June 25th 1908,

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said

James H. Dean & Mary C. Dean do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance theron, free and clear of all incumbrances except as above recited, that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet & peaceful possession of said party, her heirs and assigns, never against the lawful claimants. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Thirteen Hundred Dollars

according to the terms of one certain mortgage note this day executed and delivered by the said Parties of the first part to the said part of the second part due in five years from date with interest as evidenced by corpora attached thereto.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
