This Indenture, Made this 25th day of March in the year of our Lord Nineteen
Hundred and Nine, between Lewis L. Phillips and Cora V. Phillips
his wife, of Lawrence in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Wm T. Sinclair
of Lawrence in the County of Douglas, of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) DOLLARS,
to them paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage
to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas,
and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The south ninety (90) feet of lot Twenty-one (21) and
Twenty-three (23), and the east half of lot Twenty-five (25),
all in Block 12, nineteen (19), in that part of the city of
Lawrence known as West Lawrence as per plat on file
in the office of the Clerk of the District Court, in suit giles vs.
Filley et al;

Parties of the first part agree to maintain insurance of (\$500)
on the buildings now or to be erected on said premises,
for the benefit of said second party, his heirs or assigns,
during the existence of this loan

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said
Lewis L. Phillips and Cora V. Phillips do hereby covenant and agree that
at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefensible
estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend
the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said second party, his heirs and
assigns from all persons lawfully claiming the same. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of
One thousand Dollars

according to the terms of one certain mortgage note this day executed
and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part
due in five years from date, with interest from date to maturity or evidenced by
coupons attached thereto and interest after maturity or default at the rate of
ten percent per annum until fully paid in cash or by Sheriff's Deed to above described
property and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof,
or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount
shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at
any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising
from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the
overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
