NOW, If said part 2 of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part 2 of the second part, its successors heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sum of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due, if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon shall by these presents become due and payable, and said part 2 of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.

and this instrument is made executed and delivered upon the following conditions, to wit: Said parties will pay monthly into the said party of the second part in the principal sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars payable according to the terms and effect of the certain first Mortgage held, executed and delivered by the said parties fifth first day of February 1907, and pay also the interest of the said party of the second part on the first day of March 1907 with interest from March first 1907 until maturity at the rate of eight per cent per annum payable semi annually on the first days of March and September in each year and for next four years for maturity, the installments of interest being further evidenced by six interest coupons attached hereto and for ever date thereafter, and payable on like manner. Said parties to be liable for principal and interest to incur for the period of this loan for at least twenty Four hundred Two Dollars for the length of the said mortgage, or its aggregate, and so under such insurance to be made payable to them according to their interests, and also agree to have any release of this mortgage made by said mortgage or its coupons recorded at the expense of said parties of the first part.
