PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this expressed condition, that whereas said

ha this day executed and delivered certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part of which the following cop :

NOW, If said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, the sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sum of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon shall, and by these presents become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.

And, this instrument is made, executed and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit: Said parties of the first part are justly indebted unto the said party of the second part, in the principal sum of One Thousand Dollars, payable according to the true and effect of one certain First Mortgage, to be executed and delivered by said parties of the first part bearing date March First 1909, and payable to the holder of the said party of the second part, on the First day of March 1914, with interest thereon from date until maturity at the rate of five percent per annum, payable semi-annually, on the First day of March and September in each year, and for ever thereafter, after maturity, the instruments of First Mortgagor, further evidenced by the indentures attached to said first mortgage note and of ever date, hereinafter and payable in like manner. Said parties of the first part agree to secure said real property for the sum of two thousand One Thousand Dollars for the sum of the said mortgage, or its successor, any loss under such insurance to be made by them according to their liability, and also to give or release to the mortgagor of said mortgage to its successors recorded at the expense of said parties of the first part.
