

COUPON MORTGAGE - Local Co., Platte, Lincoln and State Bank, Kansas City, Mo.

This Indenture, Made this 28th day of September in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred 1909 between E. F. Engel and Cora E. Engel his wife

of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and S. M. Cramer of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Hundred and no/100 (\$1600.00) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and mortgage to the said part 2nd of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The South Eight acres of the West 20 acres of the South Half (1/2) of the South West Quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twelve (12), Range Nineteen (19) East of the Sixth principal Meridian, Also Beginning 40 rods East of the South West Corner of said South West Quarter (1/4), Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19), thence East 12 rods, more or less to centre of a road running North and South; Thence North along said road 27-6/10 rods; thence West to said tract first above described; thence South to place of beginning, last tract containing two (2) acres, more or less

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said part 1st of the first part therein. And the said E. F. Engel and Cora E. Engel his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This Grant is intended as a MORTGAGE to secure the payment of the sum of Sixteen hundred and no/100 (\$1600.00) Dollars, according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed by the said E. F. Engel and Cora E. Engel, his wife, to the said part 2nd of the second part. Said note being given for the sum of Sixteen hundred (\$1600.00) and no/100 Dollars, dated September 28th 1909 due and payable in five years from date hereof, with interest thereon from the date thereof until paid, according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as in said note and coupons thereto attached, and as is hereinafter specified. And the said part 1st of the first part hereby agree to pay all taxes assessed on said premises before any penalties or costs shall accrue on account thereof, and to keep the said premises insured in favor of the said mortgagee, in the sum of one DOLLARS, in some insurance company satisfactory to said mortgagee, in default whereof the said mortgagee may pay the taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs, and insure the same at the expense of the part 1st of the first part, and the expense of such taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs, and insurance, shall from the payment thereof, be and become an additional lien under this mortgage upon the above described premises, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes assessed on said premises, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole principal of said note, and interest thereon, and all taxes and accruing penalties and interest and costs thereon remaining unpaid or which may have been paid by the party of the second part, and all sums paid by the party of the second part for insurance, shall be due and payable or not at the option of the party of the second part; and it shall be lawful for the party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due or to become due according to the conditions of this instrument, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand, to the said parties of the first part his heirs and assigns.
