

This Indenture, made the First day of DECEMBER, A.D. 1908

between Sylvester Stull and Mary B. Stull Husband and Wife of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, party of the first part, and The Prudential Trust Company, a corporation under the laws of Kansas, located at Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred and No/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

The West Half of the North-east-quarter-of-Section-No. Thirty-one (31) Township No. Twelve (12), Range Eighteen (18) - Douglas County State of Kansas aforesaid; less Two (2) acres in the South-West corner and Three (3) acres in the Northwest-corner-of-above-described land, which has been sold for town-lots.

To Have And To Hold the same, with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, including any right of homestead and every contingent right or estate therein, unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, the intention being to convey an absolute title in fee to said premises.

And the said Parties of the first part hereby covenant that they are lawfully seized of said premises and have good right to convey the same; that said premises are free and clear of all incumbrances; and that they will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

Provided, However, that if the said party of the first part shall pay, or cause to be paid, to the said party of the second part, its successors or assigns, the principal sum of Fifteen Hundred and No/100 Dollars, on the first day of December, A.D. 1913, with interest thereon at the rate of Five per cent. per annum, payable on the first day of June and December in each year, together with interest at the rate of ten per cent. per annum on any installment of interest which shall not have been paid when due, and on said principal sum after the same becomes due or payable, according to the tenor and effect of a promissory note, bearing even date herewith, executed by the said Parties of the first part and payable at the office of The Prudential Trust Company, in Topeka, Kansas; and shall perform all and singular the covenants herein contained; then this mortgage to be void and to be released at the expense of said party of the first part, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

And the said party of the first part do hereby covenant and agree to pay, or cause to be paid, the principal sum and interest above
