

The description of the Pipe Line Company's properties in the mortgage of August 1, 1907, contains the following—

XIV.

ALTOONA-GRABHAM 16-INCH LINE.

All that certain gas pipe line, constructed during the year 1907, starting at the southern terminus of the Kansas City 16-inch line, within township 29 N., range 16 E., Wilson County, Kansas, and running thence in a generally southerly direction.

XV.

RIGHTS OF WAY, ALTOONA-GRABHAM 16-INCH LINE.

To be subdivided and described in a Supplemental Mortgage to be hereafter executed.

Now therefore this supplemental indenture or mortgage witnesseth, that in order to more fully describe the Altoona-Grabham 16-inch line, and to schedule and describe the Rights of Way, Altoona-Grabham 16-inch line, the Pipe Line Company, in consideration of the premises, and of the acceptance and purchase thereof by all present and future holders of bonds issued and to be issued under the mortgage of August 1, 1907, and of the sum of one dollar, lawful money of the United States, to it paid by the Trustee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has executed and delivered this supplemental indenture or mortgage, and has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, conveyed, confirmed, assigned, transferred, set over and mortgaged, and hereby does grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, convey, confirm, assign, transfer, set over and mortgage unto the Trustee, its successors or assigns, in this trust created by the mortgage of August 1, 1907,

Following are schedules of the grants of the rights of way hereby conveyed, showing the name of the Grantor, the date of the grant, the date when, and the book and page where recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of the county where the property affected is located, a description of the property by fraction, or part, of section, and section, township and range numbers, and the name of the original grantee, the abbreviation "Kaw" indicating the Kaw Gas Company, and the abbreviation "Imp" indicating The Kansas Natural Gas, Oil, Pipe Line & Improvement Company. The schedules are two in number, one for each county where properties affected are located.
