This Indenture made this ____ day of May 1909 By and between Violet McKone and W. H. McKone her husband, of the City of Tonganoxie and County of Leavenworth, and State of Kansas, parties of the first part, and The Tonganoxie Building and Loan Association, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas of the City and County aforesaid, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, The said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of ____ hundred dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of whereof hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to its assigns, all of the following described Real estate, lying and situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: A tract of land in the North East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty six (36) Township Twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19) Known as part of the Reserve in Lane's First addition to the city of Lawrence more particularly described as as follows. Beginning at a point in the West line of Mississippi Street in the city of Lawrence, 120 feet North of the North East corner of Lot One (1) in Block Nine (9) Lane's First addition; Thence west on line parallel with the South line of Henry Street 125 feet; Thence South 65 feet. Thence East 125 feet; Thence North 65 feet to place of beginning.

To Have And Hold the same, with all and singular, the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, and its assigns forever.

Provided always, and these presents are on these express conditions, that whereas, the said Violet McKone, a member of said Tonganoxie Building and Loan Association, and a holder of 25 shares in Series ____ has this 28th day of May A. D. 1909, obtained a loan from said Company in the Sum of Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.), and has this day executed and delivered a promissory note therefore in writing, to the said party of the second part of which the following is a copy, to-wit:
