Witnesseth; that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred and No/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:- The East 1/2 of North East 1/4 and 95 feet off North side of the North east 1/4 of south west 1/4, Also the South West 1/4 of North East 1/4 less 95 feet off South side of said South West 1/4 of said North East 1/4 all in Section I Township I2 Range I7, To Have And to Hold the same, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining including any right of homestead and every contingent right or estate therein, unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever; the intention being to convey an absolute title in fee to said premises.
