

Whereas, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered to The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, by John Shrimplin secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Douglas County, Kansas, dated September 26, 1904, and recorded in said County on October 17th 1904 in Volume 38 of mortgages on page 387, the sum of one thousand Dollars with interest from April 1st 1909; and Whereas, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Charles L. Shirar subject to said mortgage; and Whereas, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note and mortgage payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided. Now Therefore, the said Charles L. Shirar hereby agrees to pay interest on said sum from April 1, 1909 to September 26, 1909 at the rate of five per centum per annum, and thereafter until paid at the rate of 5½ per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and to pay the principal sum remaining unpaid as aforesaid on September 26, 1914 with the privilege of paying one hundred dollars or more of said principal sum on any interest paying day after September 26, 1910 and before maturity; And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage, and all their covenants and conditions, shall remain in force except as herein modified.
