

Whereas, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered to  
 B  
 The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, by William Roberts secured  
 by a mortgage upon real estate in Douglas County, Kansas, dated October  
 20th 1904, and recorded in said County on November 14th 1904 in Volume 38  
 of mortgages on page 389 the sum of nine thousand Dollars, with interest  
 from April 1st 1909; and Whereas, title to the mortgaged premises is now  
 vested in William B. Roberts subject to said mortgage and; Whereas the said  
 Insurance Company has been requested to make said note and mortgage payable  
 as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the  
 payments to be made as herein provided. Now Therefore, the said William B.  
 Roberts hereby agrees to pay interest on said sum from April 1st 1909 until  
 paid at the rate of five per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and to  
 pay the principal sum remaining unpaid as aforesaid on October 20th 1914  
 with the privilege of paying one hundred dollars or more of said principal X  
 sum on any interest-paying day after October 20th 1910 and before maturity;  
 And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree  
 that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that  
 said note and mortgage, and all their covenants and conditions shall re-  
 main in full force except as herein modified.
