NORTH PETROLIA 16-INCH LINE.

All that certain gas pipe line approximately 17 miles long, constructed by the Marnet Construction Company during the year 1900, starting from a point at or near the northwest corner of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 24, Range 18, Allen County, Kansas, on the site of the Pipe Line Company's Petrolia Compressor Station Extension hereinafter mentioned and described, and extending thence in a generally northerly direction for a distance of about 14 miles to a point on the Neosho River in the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 24, Range 18, Allen County, Kansas, thence in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 3 miles to a point in the southeast corner of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 24, Range 18, Allen County, Kansas, at which point it connects with the so-called St. Joseph Line of the Kansas Natural Gas Company and the Pipe Line Company's so-called Kansas City 16-Inch Line. The North Petrolia 16-Inch Line does not include a crossing at the Neosho River, it being connected with the Pipe Line Company's The North Petrolia 16-Inch Line on both north and south banks of the Neosho River, but does include certain connections at the outlet of the Kansas City 16-Inch Line on the north and south banks of the Neosho River, consisting of approximately 800 feet of 10-Inch pipe starting south of Scatter Creek and crossing the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railroad north of and parallel to the Pipe Line Company's two 10-Inch Lines;

Being the same gas pipe line conveyed to the Pipe Line Company by the Kaw Gas Company, The Kansas Natural Gas, Oil, Pipe Line and Improvement Company, the Marnet Construction Company, and Kansas Natural Gas Company by deed dated February 1, 1910 recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the counties mentioned below on the dates and in the records indicated:—

RIGHTS OF WAY, NORTH PETROLIA 16-INCH LINE.

All the Pipe Line Company's interest in and to, or by, through or under, certain grants-of rights of way over and across lands and along and across highways in Allen County, Kansas, the

interest of the Pipe Line Company therein and thereunder, being, in such rights of way as were granted prior to the year 1909, only so much thereof as is embraced within two lines drawn respectively 18" from a line parallel with the center of the North Petrolia 16" Line, and the whole thereof in such rights of way as were granted in the year 1909, which interest of the Pipe Line Company was conveyed to the Pipe Line Company by The Kaw Gas Company, The Kansas Natural Gas, Oil, Pipe Line and Improvement Company, the Marnet Construction Company and the Kansas Natural Gas Company, by the aforesaid deed dated February 1, 1910.

Following is a schedule of the grants of the rights of way a part or the whole whereof is hereby conveyed, showing the name of the Grantor, the date of the grant, the date when and the book and page where recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County where the property affected is located, a description of the property by fraction, or part of section, and section, township and range numbers, and the name of the original grantee, the abbreviation "Imp." indicating The Kansas Natural Gas, Oil, Pipe Line and Improvement Company and the abbreviation "Mar." indicating the Marnet Construction Company.
