Hughes of the second part, WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to-wit: Lot no six (6) in vacated town of Black Jack 2 7/100 acres more or less in the west half of the west half of North East qr section 7 known as Lot No 5 in the village of Black Jack.
