But if said sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, are not paid when the same are due; and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall become due and payable without notice, and this mortgage may thereupon be foreclosed.
