

seven in township thirteen, range nineteen; and sections twelve, eleven, three, four and five in township thirteen, range eighteen; and sections thirty-two, thirty-one and thirty in township twelve, range eighteen; and section twenty-five, twenty-six and twenty-three, in township twelve, range seventeen to a point in the county line between Douglas and Shawnee counties, near the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of last mentioned section twenty-three.

(c) Eight inch branch line which connects with and runs from the sixteen inch line described in sub-paragraph (a), and runs westerly therefrom across section thirty-two in township twelve, range twenty to the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

(d) Sixteen inch trunk line which runs from a point in the County line between Douglas and Franklin counties, near the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of section sixteen, township fifteen, range twenty-one northeasterly across sections sixteen, fifteen and ten in township fifteen, range twenty-one to a point in County line between Douglas and Johnson counties near the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the south east quarter of said last mentioned section ten.

(e) Four inch branch line which connects with and runs from the sixteen inch trunk line described in sub-paragraph (a), eastwardly across sections six, five and four in township fifteen, range twenty, and section thirty-two in township fourteen range twenty, to the city of Baldwin in said Douglas County.

(f) Four inch branch line which connects with and runs from the twelve inch line described in sub-paragraph (b) at a point in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section eighteen, township thirteen, range twenty, and runs thence northerly over United States Government lands to Haskell Institute.

A plot or map showing in red ink so much of the above described pipe lines as lie within Douglas County, Kansas, is hereto attached, marked Exhibit A<sup>2</sup> and made a part hereof, as fully as though incorporated at length herein.

Second. Also all the rights of way upon which the said pipe lines are laid. The said rights of way, situate in Douglas County, Kansas, are described as follows:-

1. Right of way dated June 12, 1905, made by Charles C. Miller, <sup>and Emma J. Miller</sup> to the Kansas Natural Gas, Oil Pipe Line and Improvement Company (hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement Company") and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Douglas County, Kansas, in Book \_\_\_\_ at page 363. The land over which the said right of way is granted being the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section sixteen township twelve, range twenty.
2. Right of way dated July 19, 1905, made by Willis Hackley, widower, to the said Improvement Company, and recorded in the said Register's office in Deed Book 78, at page 362. The land over which the said right of way is granted being five acres of land in the northeast corner of the northeast quarter of section twenty-one township twelve, range twenty.
3. Right of way dated July 12, 1905, made by L. S. Puroell, S. M. Puroell and Mrs. Lucy Puroell to the said Improvement Company, and recorded in the said Register's office in Deed Book 78, at page 361. The land over which the said right of way is granted being
