This Indenture, made and entered into this 19th day of December 1911, between J. A. Garst, A. J. Wine and Mrs B. S. Katherman trustees of the Lawrence Congregation of the Church of the Brethren in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas connected with the District of N.E. District of Ka. of the first part and the General Mission Board of the Church of the Brethren of the city of Elgin, County of Kane, and State of Illinois of the second part; Witnesseth, that, whereas, the parties of the first part do hereby represent and declare that they and their predecessors in office have a warranty deed to, and do now hold, the premises hereinafter described in trust, that said premises shall be held, kept, maintained, and disposed of as a place of worship of the Church of the Brethren, subject to the discipline, usage, and ministerial appointment of said church, as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference of said Church, and the District Meeting within whose bounds the said premises may be situated; And Whereas, the party of the second part, in consideration of the uses and purposes to which said premises are devoted, as hereinbefore declared, and the obligation of this indenture, hereinafter stated, has loaned to the parties of the first part the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) to be secured and repaid as hereinafter set out; NOW in consideration of the premises Hereinbefore recited, and of the said sum of money so borrowed, the parties of the first part have bargained and sold and do by these presents grant, alien, and convey unto the party of the second part, the said General Mission Board of the Church of the Brethren, all the following described real estate to-wit: Part of the Southwest quarter of section thirty-one (31) in township twelve (12) of Range Twenty (20) described as follows to-wit: Begin at a point on the east line of New Hampshire street in the City of Lawrence, proceed South thirty three (33) feet from the North line of Adams street, thence run East

The following is endorsed on the original instrument.

The conditions of the within mortgage having been complied with we hereby cancel and release the same and authorize the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, State of Kansas, to discharge the same of record.
