of not less than Fifteen Hundred Dollars, loss, if any, payable to the party of the second part or his assigns, as his interest may appear; and if additional insurance be procured thereon, and the policies therefor shall not be made in terms payable as herein specified, the company placing such additional insurance shall nevertheless make contribution in case of loss to the same extent as it would be required to do if said policies had been so made payable and delivered to the perty of the second part as additional and collateral security for the payment of sain debt.
