THAT, HEREAS, the undersigned

bouglas , State of Kansas , hereinafter called fortgagor, and the United States of America, acting by and through the Secretary of Agriculture pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Bank-band day of October , 1946, by the United States of America, whereby the United States agreed to make a loan to the Mortgagor; and

MHEREAS, the Mortgagor executed a certain promiseery note dated the Seven Thousand Mine Sunder Thirty and no/100----- Dallars (\$7.920,000 f), with interest at the rate of three per cent (3%) per annum, principal and interest payable in forty installments of Three Hundred Thorty-three and 05/100- Dollars each. The first such installment shall be payable on the 1 day of Manch. 1945; the next succeeding thirty-sight installments, annually thereafter; and the fortisth installment, either thirty-nine years thereafter or forty years from the date of said note, whichever date is the earlier; and

WHEREAS, said note was made payable to the United States of America at the effice of the Farm Security Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, at <u>Lincoln</u>, Webrasha ; and

MHERRAS, by order of the Secretary of Agriculture, dated October 11, 1916, to be effective November 1, 1916, pursuant to the provisions of the Farmers' Home Administration Act of 1916 (Public Law 731, 79th Congress, approved August 14, 1916), all authorities, powers, functions and duties administered by the Farm Security Administration were transferred to the Farmers' Home Administration to be exercised by the Administrator thereof;

MERRAS, the United States of America has made the lean to the Mortgagor and the Mortgagor has become justly indebted to the United States of America, acting by and through the Administrator of the Farmers' Home Administration pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Mortgagor is desirous of securing the prompt payment of said note, and the several installments of principal and interest at maturity, and any extension or renewal thereof, and any agreement supplementary thereto, and any additional indebtedness accruing to Mortgages on account of any future advances or expenditures made as hereinafter provided, and the performance of each and every covenant and agreement of Mortgagor herein contained;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the said indebtedness and to secure the prompt payment thereof, as the same matures or becomes due, and of any extension or renewal thereof, or of any agreement supplementary thereto, and to secure the performance of each and every covenant and agreement of fortgager herein contained, Mortgager does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the United States of America, acting by and through the Administrator of the Parmers' Home Administration, whose post-office address is Farmers Home Administration, U.S.D.A., Topelas, Kansas pareinafter called Mortgages, the following described real estate situated in the County of Douglas state of Kansas, to wits
