 to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do—grant, bargain, sell and mortgage
 to the said part 2d of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas,
 State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

the South half (1/2) of the South West Quarter (S.W. 1/4)
of Section twenty six (26) Township fourteen (14) Range
seventeen (17) East of 6th P. M.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part 1st of the first part therein. And the said
parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that
 at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances except 3000.00 Mortgage to
Geo H. Housie & Dated Sept 1st 1910 due in 5 years
after date This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of
41000.00

according to the terms of One certain promissory note this day executed
 and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said part 2d of the second part

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof,
 or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount
 shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part 2d of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at
 any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising
 from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the
 overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part 1st making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part, their
 heirs and assigns.
