 hundred and twelve, between James A. Reihl and Katie Reihl,
Sic-ut-hi, of the Township of Kansas in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and
Ruth Blair of the second part:

Witnesseth. That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Three Thousand DOLLARS,
 to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage
 to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas,
 and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The East half of the Northeast quarter (1/4) of Section Number 24 (36) in Township
 Number 12 of Range Eighteen (18), except a tract of land in angular form in the Northwest
 corner of said quarter section, in said County and state;

The mortgagors agree to keep the buildings on premises insured against fire, lightning
 and wind damage to their actual value, in a company or companies approved by
 this mortgagee, with mortgagee being loss payable to said mortgagee, or his
 assigns, as critical may appear, and failing to do so holder of mortgage may have
 same insured and the cost of doing added to the mortgage to have interest until
 paid at 10%.

 at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible

Three Thousand Dollars This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said Parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
