WITNESSETH, That said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty (\$450⁰⁰) and DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, and Convey unto said part of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, to wit:

Comprising 24 rods and 4 feet south of the north west corner of the north west quarter section 24 Township 3 Range 18, hence running south 73 rods and 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence east 43 rods and 6 inches; thence - 73 rods and 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence west 43 rods and 6 inches to place of beginning less 10 rods square out of north east corner of said tract

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said

P. F. Lamb and A. H. Lamb, her husband,
 on this day executed and delivered one certain promissory note...in writing to said part of the second part, of which the following is a copy \$450⁰⁰ Lawrence Kansas, Oct 2nd 1912
 Due one month after date we promise to pay to the order of A. H. Wilson, Four hundred and fifty Dollars (\$450⁰⁰)
 Privilege is hereby given to pay \$100, or any multiple at any interest paying date
 value received with interest at the rate of 7% per annum from date interest payable semi annually.

NOW, If said part of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part of the second part, her heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described note, mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be fully discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sum of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable, and said part of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
