Commencing at the North East Corner of the North West fractional Quarter of Section Three (3), Township Twelve (12), Range Eighteen (18), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, and running from thence South on the East line of said Quarter Section, Fifty Nine (59) rods; Thence West Twenty Seven (27) rods; One (1) foot, Nine (9) inches; thence North Fifty Nine (59) rods, to the North line of said Section; Thence East on said Section line Twenty Seven (27) rods, One (1) foot, Nine (9) inches, to the place of beginning, Containing Ten (10) acres more or less.

But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable, and said part 2d of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
