WITNESSETH, That said part ies of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred Eighty six and 25/₁₀₀ DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, and Convey unto said part y of the second part, his

heirs and assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, to wit: The South end of the Str. of the Block of N. W. 1/4 of Section 29 Township 12, Range 20, Thence East 12 rods, thence North 12 rods, thence West 12 rods, thence South 12 rods, to the beginning of the following, Beginning 20 rods East of the center of the West line of N. W. 1/4 of Section 29, Township 12, Range 20, thence South 1/2 rods, thence West 1/2 rods, thence East 1/2 rods, thence South 1/2 rods, to the beginning of the following, Beginning at a point 12 rods East of the center of the West line of the N. W. 1/4 of Section 29, Township 12, Range 20, thence South 1/2 rods, thence West 1/2 rods, thence East 1/2 rods, thence South 1/2 rods, to the place of beginning, all of said parcels as described being the part of the City of Lawrence, formerly known as North Lawrence, same being subject however to a W. E. Weber Trust of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, to have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said C. A. Hicks and Jessie A. Hicks, his wife have at this day executed and delivered two certain promissory notes in writing to said part y of the second part, of which the following are copies: Lawrence, Kansas June 1, 1916

\$200 One year after date, we or either of us, promise to pay to the order of W. M. Lindley at Lawrence National Bank, Ninety three and 100/₁₀₀ Dollars, for value received, with interest at eight percent per annum, after date until paid, interest payable annually, Jessie A. Hicks
June 1, 1917 Lawrence, Kansas June 1, 1916
Two years after date, we or either of us, promise to pay to the order of W. M. Lindley at Lawrence National Bank, Ninety three and 100/₁₀₀ Dollars, for value received, with interest at eight percent per annum, after date, until paid, interest payable annually, C. A. Hicks
Jessie A. Hicks

NOW, It said part ies of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part y of the second part, his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described notes mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable, and said part y of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
