One Hundred Twenty Two & 85/100 Dollars, with interest at the rate of eight per cent
per annum from date until due. Value received. Interest payable semi-annually
interest at rate of 10 per cent per annum after maturity.

We the makers, endorsers, assignors and sureties, severally waive
presentment for payment, demand, protest and notice of protest, for non-payment
of this note.

NOW, If said part 1st of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part 1st of the second part successors heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable, and said part 1st of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
