One Hundred Ninety & 00/100 (\$190.00) and 100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, and Convey unto said part 2^d of the second part, her
 heirs and assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, to wit: Lots No. Seven, eight,
Nine, Ten, Eleven, Twelve, Thirteen and Fourteen (7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 & 14)
in Block No. Seventy-five situated in the city of Eudora.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise
 appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said A. D. Lee and Emma J. Lee,
his wife

has on this day executed and delivered One certain promissory note in writing to said part 2^d of the second part, of which the
 following is a copy:

Three years after date we promise to pay to the order of Aime
E. Lee One Hundred Ninety & 00/100 Dollars at Eudora, Kansas.
Value received with interest at the rate of six per cent per
annum from date until paid, interest payable annually.

NOW, If said part 1st of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part 2^d of the second part her heirs or assigns, said sum of
 money in the above-described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly
 discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid
 when the same is due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid
 when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable, and
 said part 2^d of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
