

## MORTGAGE RECORD.

This Indenture, Made this 21st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred Thirteen between R. M. Morrison and Ida C. Morrison, his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and President of Board of Trustees of Kansas Yearly Meeting of Friends, a corporate Body of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have well sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Lot One Hundred Twenty Four (134) and One Hundred Thirty six (136) Ohio Street, Lawrence, Kansas

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of of the first part therein. And the said R. M. Morrison and Ida C. Morrison do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One thousand DOLLARS, according to the terms of one certain promissory note, this day executed by the said R. M. Morrison and Ida C. Morrison

to the said part of of the second part; said note being given for the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS, dated March 21, 1913, due and payable in Five year/s from date thereof, with interest thereon from the date thereof until paid according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached, and as hereinafter specified. And the said parties of the first part hereby agree to pay all taxes assessed on said premises before any penalties or costs shall accrue on account thereof, and to keep the said premises

insured in favor of the said mortgagee, in the sum of One thousand DOLLARS, in some insurance company satisfactory to said mortgagee, in default whereof the said mortgagee may pay the taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs, and insure the same at the expense of the part of of the first part, and the expense of such taxes and accruing penalties, interest and costs, and insurance, shall, from the payment thereof, be and become an additional lien under this mortgage upon the above described premises, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof or interest thereon or the taxes assessed on said premises or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole principal of said note, and interest thereon, and all taxes and accruing penalties and interest and costs thereon remaining unpaid or which may have been paid by the part of of the second part, and all sums paid by the part of of the second part for insurance, shall be due and payable or not, at the option of the part of of the second part; and it shall be lawful for the part of of the second part, his executors, administrators or assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the part of of the second part, his executors, administrators or assigns, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due or to become due according to the conditions of this instrument, to pay the taxes and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of making such sale, on demand to the said R. M. Morrison, his heirs and assigns.
