

## MORTGAGE RECORD.

This Indenture, Made this First day of December, A. D. 1911, between  
Alice H. Thompson, a widow

of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and THE LAWRENCE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS, of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That the part Y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

\$600 - Six Hundred DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns,

all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to wit:

Commencing at a point two hundred (200) feet north of - point (6.60) feet  
six hundred and sixty (660) feet north of the south line; and three hundred and forty  
(340) feet east of the west line of the north west quarter of Sec six (6) Tp (13)  
and Range (20) Thence running north fifty (50) feet Thence east one  
hundred (100) feet Thence south fifty (50) feet Thence  
west one hundred (100) feet to the place of beginning  
in the City of Lawrence.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of \$600

Six Hundred DOLLARS,  
with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the contract note secured hereby, advanced by the said THE LAWRENCE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the part Y of the first part upon Six shares of Class B of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 64 which said shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said shares, the first part Y agree to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$ 7.62 payable as follows — Dollars, (\$ 7.62) on or before the last day of December 1911 and a like sum on or before the last day

of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of November 1921.

Now, if said part Y of the first part shall cease to be paid to the party of the second part the amount due it under said contract note, in accordance with the terms thereof, and comply with all the provisions and agreements in said note contained, then these presents shall be void; otherwise in full force and effect, and may be foreclosed as in said contract note provided.
