 all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to wit:

of Lot No. One Hundred Twenty-eight (128) and all of Lot No. One hundred
thirty, (130) on Illinois Street in the City of Lawrence, County

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the vicissitudes, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of One Hundred Fifty DOLLARS,
 with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the contract note secured hereby, advanced by the said THE LAWRENCE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the part y of the first part upon 1 1/2 shares of Class 14 of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 28 which said shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said shares, the first part y agree s to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$ 6.90 payable as follows six and 90/100 Dollars, (\$ 6.90) on or before the last day of June 1914 and a like sum on or before the last day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of May 1916.
