

MORTGAGE RECORD.

This Indenture, Made this 29 day of April, A. D. 1916, between
Fred Love and Estella May Love, his wife

of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and THE LAWRENCE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS, of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That the part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Five hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns,

all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to wit:

Lots Numbered Seventy-eight (78) and Eighty (80) on South side of Lincoln Street
in Block Fifty-five (55) in that part of the City of Lawrence known as
West Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of

Five hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
 with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the contract note
 security hereby advanced by the said THE LAWRENCE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the part of the first part upon 5 shares of
 Class Common Stock of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 2115 which said shares have been assigned to said
 Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said shares, the first part agree to pay in
 monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$10.35, payable as follows Ten and 35/100 Dollars,
 (\$10.35) on or before the last day of May 1916, and a like sum on or before the last day
 of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of April 1921.

Now, if said part of the first part shall cause to be paid to the party of the second part the amount due it under said contract note, in accordance with the
 terms thereof, and comply with all the provisions and agreements in said note contained, then these presents shall be void; otherwise in full force and effect, and may
 be foreclosed as in said contract note provided.
