AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 17085.

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered to the Prudential Insurance Company of America by Dick Bowen Stone and Nellie R. And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage, and all the covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
